Location . . . The Hotel Carlisle is conveniently located on US Route 11, two miles south of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Interstate 76 at exit 226 or at exit 52 off Interstate 81.

The Site . . . Show headquarters will be the scenic 28-acre Hotel Carlisle & Embers Convention Center located in Carlisle, Pennsylvania. The hotel features 267 oversized guest rooms and suites all on the ground floor. Home-like room amenities include all the essentials to keep you looking and feeling your best. The hotel and convention center offers business class rooms featuring microwaves and refrigerators and spacious office stations in addition to the standard amenities. Special hotel amenities include a heated indoor pool, sauna, hot tub, fitness center, game room, room service, 24-hour business center, and wireless Internet access. The show rings, grooming tent, and vendors will all be on site at the host hotel.

Pennsylvania's climate in early May can be unpredictable, so come prepared for all kinds of weather. Plan to bring warm clothing, clothing that can be "layered," hats, gloves, rain gear, and boots. The average high temperature for the week of the Specialty is 62 degrees, and the average low temperature is 40 degrees.

If this is your first visit to our area, you may want to stop by and visit with the helpful front desk staff. They are always happy to make restaurant recommendations, to help you find your way around, or to point out activities that they think you'll enjoy.

In addition, there's no shortage of things to do in Hershey, Harrisburg, Lancaster, and many other nearby communities. Hershey's company town, Hershey is now a place rich with activities, scenic gardens, and tempting treats. Air Travel & Airport Transportation . . . The closest airport is Harrisburg, located approximately 35 minutes from Carlisle, but not all major airlines fly into this location. There is no shuttle service to the hotel. If you are transporting dogs, we recommend the following airports (driving distances between 2 to 3½ hours): Baltimore, Maryland (BWI); Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (PHL); Newark, New Jersey (EWR); Reagan Airport/Washington National (DCA).

Be a Considerate Guest . . . Please do your part to uphold our reputation as considerate guests. Exercise your dogs in designated areas only, and use the plastic bags and trash receptacles provided to facilitate clean up. No electrical cords may be run from hotel rooms through windows to any outdoor areas. We need everyone's help in keeping the hotel rooms and show grounds, including grooming areas, clean.

Room Reservations . . . We have reserved all 267 rooms at the Hotel Carlisle, but reservations may not be postmarked prior to January 10, 2012. (Reservations postmarked prior to January 10, 2012, will be returned.) Reservations must be made on the reservation form on page 16 and include a deposit of one night's lodging. The reservation form may be duplicated. There is a \$20 non-refundable one time cleaning fee, which will be applied to every reservation at the Hotel Carlisle.

Please be considerate when making reservations. Every year, unneeded reservations are made, only to be canceled at a later date, creating unnecessary confusion for potential guests and the hotel staff. (To avoid making duplicate reservations, guests who preregistered at the 2011 Specialty will receive confirmation of their room reservation prior to January 10.) If you must cancel reservations, please do so as early as possible. Reservations must be canceled by March 1 to receive a full refund.

Once the Hotel Carlisle is fully booked, overflow hotels will be available to accommodate additional reservations. If you choose this option, please indicate your preference by number choice on the reservation form.

RV Parking . . . Come to Camp Newf and enjoy the show! RV parking will once again be available on site at the NCA National. Parking for approximately 30 RVs will be located on a grassy area approximately 150 feet from the conformation rings and convenient to Hospitality, vendors and the hotel. The RV parking fee is \$35 per day.

There will be no water, electric or sewer hook-up provided, but we will schedule holding tank pump-outs for a fee during the week. Information on dump/refill sites near the show site will be provided, as well as local RV supply and repair locations.

The first postmark date accepted for RV Parking is January 10, 2012. If using expedited delivery services, please waive the signature. Reservation deadline is April 2 or when the RV parking area is filled. No refunds after April 2, 2012.

This will be a great opportunity to gain ring experience for your puppies, a refresher course for the veterans, and lots of breed points for those looking ahead to the 2013 Top Twenty.

Daytime Parking . . . A limited number of parking spaces in close proximity to the rings will be available for exhibitors not staying at the host hotel. Additional day parking will be available for spectators in front of the host hotel.

Reserved Parking . . . Seventy-five percent of reserved parking will be allocated to exhibitors with three or more dogs entered. The remaining 25 percent will be for exhibitors with up to three dogs entered in the show. Power will not be available in the reserved parking area. Quiet time is from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Generators are not permitted to operate during quiet time. No RVs or overnight camping are permitted in this area.

Buddy Parking: If you would like to be parked next to a friend or group of exhibitors, reservation forms must be received together in the same envelope.

January 10 is the first postmark to send in reservations. Reservations received with a January 11, 2012, postmark or later will be allocated spaces based on availability with preference given to those exhibitors with three or more dogs entered. The deadline for reservations is April 2 or when all available spaces have been assigned. No refunds are available after April 2. Reservation confirmation will be sent upon receipt of form by email or USPS.

Reserved Grooming and Crate Space . . . The grooming tent will be available for set-up at noon on Saturday. Power will be available beginning Saturday, April 28 at 6 a.m. until two hours after the conclusion of Best of Breed judging on Saturday. Daily hours will be 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. until Saturday when all set-ups must be removed within two hours after the conclusion of the Best of Breed judging.

There will be a limited number of reserved grooming spaces available in the grooming tent adjacent to the conformation ring. There are 153 5' x 10' spaces that will include enough room for two crates and one grooming table, and each will have a 110 electric drop. The cost for each of these spaces is \$65 for the week. There are no adjacent spaces available without electric; all spaces will have electric service.

In addition there are 17 spaces, which are located along the front of the grooming tent parallel to the breed ring that are 10' x 10' with a 110 electric drop. The cost for each of these spaces is \$100 for the week.

Dogs cannot be left in their crates overnight. Also, privately owned generators are not permitted within a 50-foot radius of the grooming tent; high intensity lights or canopies are not permitted inside the grooming tent.

The first postmark date accepted for reserved grooming space is January 10, 2012. If using expedited delivery services, please waive the signature. Reservation deadline is April 2.

Dog Bathing and Grooming . . . Washing stations with warm water will be set up for your convenience. No bathing or grooming is permitted in the hotel rooms or on hotel porches. Also, no electric lines may be run from a hotel room to the outside.

Registration . . . When you register for the Specialty, you will receive an attractive Welcome Bag filled with important information and an official name tag. Your name tag is your ticket for all events where food is served, such as the Welcome Reception. The requirement of showing your name tag at these events will be strictly enforced. Registration fees help to provide amenities, such as the Hospitality Area where coffee and snacks are provided each day at no additional charge.

The registration fee for the 2012 National is \$35 per adult. The fee for Juniors (ages 8-18) is \$20 for the first child and \$15 for each additional child in the family. This year there is no reduced fee for "early bird registration," but there will be something *extra special* in the welcome packets for the first 800 registrations!

For your convenience, registered participants can pick up welcome packets at the following times: Sunday, April 29, Monday, April 30, and Tuesday, May 1, from 9:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. in the rear lobby of the hotel.

Beginning Wednesday 2, welcome packets can be picked up in the indoor hospitality area.

Registrations by mail must be postmarked on or before April 2, 2012. Only limited on-site registration will be available after that date.

Show Handling Clinic . . . This clinic, conducted by Carol Brown, will concentrate on people new to showing dogs. The only requirements for participation are a dog and a show collar and lead. The clinics will be held under the main tent approximately 30 minutes following conclusion of judging on Wednesday through Friday. Adults and juniors are welcome, and the emphasis will be on juniors the day before Junior Showmanship is scheduled. Carol will tailor each session, building on the needs and progress of the group.
